New Orleans Inspector General Consults on NOPD Survey

Inspector General Ed Quatrevaux today released a report detailing the Office of Inspector General's contribution to the New Orleans Police Department in the design of its crime victim survey.

IG Quatrevaux said, "The consulting assistance the OIG provided will help the NOPD to obtain objective information from crime victims and analyze it with a high degree of statistical confidence. Superintendent Serpas requested our assistance, and we provided it fully aware that the statistical validity of NOPD reports will assume great importance in dealing with federal authorities. The OIG and the Police Monitor will continue to assist the NOPD in the future by providing an independent assessment of the results of NOPD initiatives and operations."
