Follow-Up Report Finds City Did Not Implement Promised Actions

The City of New Orleans Inspector General today released a Follow-Up Report: “City of New Orleans Miscellaneous Donations Fund and America’s New Orleans Fund Report”.

The City failed to update its Accounting Policies and Procedures as promised. It did issue an updated donations policy, but it was after this report was completed. The City also asserted that quarterly reports to the Council on donations were submitted, but did not provide supporting evidence. None of the promised actions for five observations were completed, e.g., the City still incurs bank charges for ANOF, which was dissolved in August 2011.

A 2nd follow-up report will be performed within eighteen months.

Inspector General Ed Quatrevaux said, “The recommended actions would prevent the City from making the same mistakes in the next disaster.”
