NOMERS ADOPTED RECOMMENDED CHANGES

The City of New Orleans Inspector General today released a report on its Follow-Up of New Orleans Municipal Retirement System's (NOMERS) Travel Policy.

The Follow-Up review determined that all five of the recommendations made in the original report have been implemented fully. The Board adopted a formal travel budget, and travel expenses and reimbursements were approved and supported adequately. Members also submitted required documentation to the Louisiana Board of Ethics.

Inspector General Ed Quatrevaux said, "The NOMERS Board did its job and fixed these shortcomings."
